BUSINESS ITEMS

The bids were opened for the street repair as advertised. Only one bidder presented bids, Bar Spur Company. The bid to repair Merino Row was \$16,296. The bid to repair Autry Street was \$13,000. After some discussion Council decided to wait on any award until we are sure of the situation at the Eden Detention Center.

City Administrator Celina Hemmeter gave Council an update on the Election. There were three Council positions up for election Councilperson Gierisch, Councilperson Spann and Councilperson Ramirez. Councilpersons Gierisch and Spann were the only two applications submitted leaving one position vacant in May. Council can appoint a person to fill the vacant position in May but at the next election in May 2018, that position would be placed on the ballot as an unexpired term of one year.

Councilperson Gierisch made a motion to approve Business Item C. February 2017 bills, seconded by Council person Spann, motion carried.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
