

## Ordinance Number 1994-4

### An ordinance regulating the keeping of animals, livestock, and fowl in the City of Eden.

Sec 3-21 - All dogs and cats, harbored or maintained by their owners within the City of Eden shall be registered

Sec 3-25 - It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any dog or cat owned or kept by him to run at large within the City of Eden.

Sec 3-41- Upon being presented a sworn affidavit that a dog or a cat has bitten or scratched a person, the animal control officer shall quarantine the dog or cat so identified for a period of ten (10) days.

Sec 3-51 - No person shall keep livestock or poultry within the city limits of the City of Eden, Texas, without first obtaining and thereafter keeping in force a permit allowing him to do so. Livestock or poultry shall be kept within structures or enclosures and not permitted to run at large.

Sec 3-61 - It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within any zone in the city any wild and /or dangerous animal as defined above unless a special annual permit is first obtained from the city council.

Sec 3-65 Limit on number of wild and/or dangerous animals. In no event shall a permit be issued for the keeping of more than two (2) wild and /or dangerous animals at any single location.

### Ordinance Number 2008-1

#### An ordinance pertaining to junked vehicles.

An ordinance adopting procedures for the abatement and removal from private or public property or a public right-of-way within the City of Eden, Texas, or its extraterritorial jurisdiction of any junked vehicle or part of a junked vehicle as a public nuisance and providing for penalties for violation of this ordinance.

## Ordinance Number 1987-7

### Garbage and Trash Ordinance



Sec 3 - Persons required keeping containers.

Every owner, agent, lessee tenant or occupant of any house, building, flat, apartment or tenement in the City of Eden, where persons reside, board, or lodge or where animal or vegetable food is prepared or served, shall provide such house, building, flat, apartment or tenement, and at all times maintain in good order and repair, a garbage or refuse container or containers for the deposit of garbage and refuse for collection.

#### Trash Accumulation

Sec 7 - (a) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place, deposit or throw, or permit or cause to be placed, deposited or thrown, any garbage, brush, loose waste or refuse of any kind, on public or private property outside of any house, building, flat or tenement in the City of Eden,

#### Sec 10- Garbage Collection Mandatory

The charges fixed herein for the removal and disposal of all garbage, brush, trash, refuse, or other waste materials shall be levied by the City of Eden against all owners, occupants, or lessees using or occupying any building, house or structure receiving such service. Since the proper and prompt removal of all garbage, brush, trash, refuse matter and other waste materials is essential to the preservation of public health and safety, it is deemed necessary that this charge be levied against every person, owner or occupant, or lessee, using or occupying any premises as a residence and thus provided for more even and equitable distribution of the cost of this service to the citizenship enjoying the benefits thereof. Where an apartment house or other building is served water through one meter, the person in whose name the

water accounts stands shall be responsible for the payment of the garbage fees for all persons in such apartment or building that are subject to the provisions of this ordinance.

### Juvenile Curfew Ordinance 2008-2

#### Curfew Hours for Minors

- (a) 11:00 p.m. on any Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday until 6:00 a.m. of the following day;
- (b) 12:01 a.m. until 6:00 a.m. on any Saturday or Sunday; and
- (c) 9:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday.

### Health and Sanitation Ordinance 2009-03

Ordinance to promote the public health, safety and general welfare within the City through the regulation of private sewage treatment facilities, stagnant filth, carrion, high weeds, dangerous weeds and other unhealthy, unsanitary and unwholesome conditions in the City. By prohibiting the creation and maintenance of such nuisances, the City Council seeks to protect property values and prevent bodily injury, death, and property damage within the City

### Commercial Vehicles on City Streets Ordinance 2008-3

The purposes of this ordinance are to prevent commercial vehicles from damaging city streets and to avoid potential dangers and hazards associated with commercial vehicles ( vehicle designed, maintained, licensed, or used primarily for the transportation of loads of 7,000 pounds or more. There are exceptions.
